






## Ecoregion Overview










Mission: The mission of the Partnership is to improve recreational opportunities and preserve greenspace and water quality within the Lake Creek Watershed.

#### **Objectives:**


- 1. Develop hiking, boating and nature viewing experiences within Lake Creek Watershed.

- 6. Assist in acquiring permanently protected land of ecological and or recreational value.

































#### POTENTIAL 20+- MILE CANOE TRAIL ALONG LAKE CREEK & BIG THICKET BOTTOMLANDS















## WHERE TO FROM HERE?

#### Near Term

- > Complete guided nature trail on county Pct2 Lake Creek Preserve.
- Clear first section of canoe trail (Fish Creek Thoroughfare to West Fork SJR)
- Integrate into HGAC watershed protection plan.
- Develop partnerships with landowners, government, businesses, non profits.
- ➤ Hold informational forums (first on at 1488HEB on October 12).
- Organize educational programs for adults & youth.

#### Long Term:

- Develop Nature Center/Community Center along Lake Creek
- Increase preserved lands along creek (easements/acquisitions)
- Identify potential sources of funding/grants
- Expand outdoor educational/recreational programs for community
