Ribbon Cutting

• The Magnolia Parkway Chamber held a ribbon cutting for the preserve on February 10 which included a tour of part of the trail system.

Lake Creek Preserve

- Two additional Eagle Scout candidates have accepted projects on the preserve. When finished we will have boardwalks over all of the significant wet areas on the Orange (western trail segment). The other Scout will add a significant section of nature guide for the western section of trail. The guide may be found on our web site at lakecreektx.org in the section on the Preserve.
- The recent road construction on Fish Creek Thoroughfare and the Woodforest Parkway have created some minor access problems.
 However, when finished plans call for improving the dirt access road and the parking area to improve wet period access.
- Maintenance schedule Bob Wise will be developing a regular trail maintenance schedule so volunteers can plan ahead as their time allows.

Canoe and Kayak Trail

- Road work has temporarily limited access to the creek at the Sendera Ranch Road Bridge. When access is restored the committee plans a trip down the creek to clear low water obstructions.
- A direct link to the USGS stream data for Lake Creek at the Sendera Ranch Rd. Bridge and the West Fork San Jacinto River at the I45 Bridge has been added to our web site in the section on Canoe and Kayak Trails.
