



The recent flooding left the southern part of the trails somewhat muddy, but drying fast provided there is no significant rain for a few weeks. The boardwalks held up fine and the only significant effect of the flood was to increase hog rooting along the trail. In that regard, John Wilson just trapped an 8' 400+lbs boar on the preserve (pictures below) that took three men to drag it several yards from the trap to truck. It was probably responsible for at least some of the rooting.

Those who have visited the preserve will notice that access is limited to daylight hours to minimize the possibility of accidently surprising on of the animals which can be dangerous. During the day, a hog encounter is much less likely especially if you make a bit of noise while you are walking the trail.





Becky Zitterich has organized a property owner meeting/presentation on hog control for January 19 at the Woodforest Golf Course dining room at 6:30. We are hoping to develop a more coordinated approach to hog control, since we need to be removing at least 2/3 of the animals each year just to keep the population stable. A follow up announcement on the January 19 meeting will be sent out after the holidays.

On a related safety note, those who walk the creek loop will notice that we have placed warning signs and a short fence at the cut bank in front of the rest bench. This was necessary as the floods of the past two years have cut about 10-20' from the bank and left it seriously undercut and subject to slumping. Please observe the signs and fence to avoid ending up in the creek.

Those who have been to the preserve in the past week would have noticed a new turn sign on north bound Fish Creek Thoroughfare and sign marking the entrance to the preserve.



Additional educational and safety signs have been installed along the orange and blue trails and we hope to add additional signage along the blue trail in the next few months. Bob Wise has established a quarterly trail maintenance schedule with work days scheduled for February 18, April 15, July 15 and November 4. We will send out notices well in advance of each work day. Since we are entirely voluntary we hope that the community will help us maintain the preserve as a recreational and educational asset for the community.

We also recently received word that we will receive a \$2500 grant from the Hauber Foundation for capital improvement to the preserve and greenway in general. Together with the Union Pacific grant we are able to help support Scout projects in the greenway, make improvements to a canoe launch at the Fish Creek Thorougfare bridge and add educational signage along the nature trails.

Regarding the February 18 work day, specific activities may include: installing an educational sign on the blue trail, leveling some of the rooting along both trails, clearing a path from the orange loop to the creek for fishing/canoe landing, clearing vines from a possible state champion River Birch and some mowing/weed eating along the trail. For planning purposes, anyone able to help should send an email to <a href="mails@lakecreektx.org">trails@lakecreektx.org</a> along with any equipment you may be able to bring: weed eaters, push mower, loppers etc.

Four additional Eagle projects are in the planning stage: one will install 4 benches along the Orange and Blue trails, one will add about 44 feet of boardwalk to the existing boardwalk on the Blue trail and the other two

are developing additional sections of the trail tree guide. We are still searching for an Eagle candidates interested in constructing an informational kiosk at the current trail head and adding sections of boardwalk along the blue trail. Our Union Pacific grant makes it possible for the Partnership to cover ½ of the materials costs for Scout projects and we have plans for the basic design.

We have also met with the Lifestyle Director with Woodforest to coordinate a spring (April 29) and fall (November 18) activity at the preserve. These and other events are posted on our web site and continually updated.

Work on the canoe trail is progressing slowly, but we have met with the San Jacinto River Authority regarding use of an improved access road to the creek at the Fish Creek Thoroughfare bridge. We are also pursuing a safer pull out downstream along the West Fork of the San Jacinto. Allen Livingston could use help on the canoe trails committee. Since our philosophy is to partner with business, property owners, government and other non-profits we have been working with local Scout troops, Woodforest Development and Commissioner Riley's staff on improvements to the entrance road and preserve and have recently met with the new director of the Bayou Land Conservancy to see how we might best work together and eliminate any duplication. Our focus will be on recreation, education and helping link landowners and residents with the appropriate resources consistent with our greenway mission.

Finally, while we have no paid positions, we do have nominal operating expenses to cover basic items such as board insurance, web site, mail box, canoe association and chamber dues, office and community event supplies. To address those needs we ask that you consider becoming a Friend of Lake Creek at least the individual \$25 level (forms attached). #### **How to Register a Digital Account**

Creating a digital account is as simple as 1,2,3! Simply visit <u>www.kroger.com</u> or download the Kroger mobile application from the appropriate app store for your device and follow these directions.
