DIRECTIONS TO LAKE CREEK PRESERVE

The 64 acre preserve is just south of the Woodforest Development and Golf Course and part of a 500+ acre nature preserve. At this time only the 64 acres is open to the public.

FROM THE INTERSECTION OF FM1488 AND FM 2978

Proceed north on Honea-Egypt Road (changes names to Sendera Ranch Drive then Fish Creek Thoroughfare at the Lake Creek bridge). Cross the bridge and the entrance to the preserve parking area will be on the right just before the first Woodforest sign. Follow the road for about two tenths of a mile. The Blue/Orange trail access and parking will be on your right.

FROM THE INTERSECTION OF FISH CREEK THOROUGHFARE AND FM 2854

Proceed south past the entrance to the Woodforest Golf Club on your left. Turn left at the light at Woodforest Parkway South if you want to access the preserve from Christine-Allen Park. If you want to access the preserve parking and orange trail head continue south across the bridge to the first road on your left (just past the end of the bridge). Use the Cul De Sac to turn around and return Across the bridge. The access to parking for the preserve parking and Orange trail head will be on your right just before the first Woodforest sign.

FROM CHRISTINE-ALLEN PARK PARKING AREA (accessed from Woodforest Parkway South)

Proceed across the footbridge that crosses the detention pond then along the top of the berm to the southwest corner of the berm and a gate marking the northeast corner of the preserve. Proceed through the gate along the improved road to the Blue trail head and kiosk on your left.
